ANNOUNCEMENT

This is normally the time of the year when we are seeking candidates for officers in the West Coast Square and Round Dance Association. However, I have been asking for volunteers with no success.

Our current secretary, Deborah Pergande, and current treasurers, John and Lynne Scott have agreed to remain in office for another year. The vice president, Jenny Green, announced a year or two ago that she does not wish to continue in this position, but she agreed to stay until we find a replacement. Jenny no longer lives in the West Coast Association area; she lives in Longwood which is north of Orlando (in the Central Association area) and she works full time in downtown Orlando.

I can no longer remain as WC president due to the decline in my health. I haven't been able to dance for three years and wouldn't have been able to even if the dances had been open. I seriously doubt I will ever be able to dance again. I am having outpatient surgery on Tuesday, August 30th, and when I recover from that, there will be another surgery. There will possibly be a third surgery after all the testing is completed. I have some square dance projects to complete, which I will do. I will not be taking on any new projects.

Even though we ran a Membership Campaign where any dancer could join for FREE. As of our last meeting on August 6th, we only have 89 members in the Association.

In addition to needing a president and vice-president, we need an insurance chairman and a sunshine chairman. We have 16 counties in our area. Out of ten county rep positions, we only have four filled. We need four or five delegates to the Florida Federation and it's time for WC to put another person on the Federation Board as treasurer. This is a four-year commitment, moving up a chair each year.

Historically, we have inducted the new officers and introduced the county reps and committee chairpersons at the President's Ball in September. The dance has been scheduled but currently, it's not the President's Ball; it's a WC Membership Dance. If we don't have volunteers for the president and vice-president positions, there will not be an election. What happens if we don't have a president and vice president? We don't have an association, and if we don't have an association we do not have a seat on the Federation Board. We will not have a say in any of the decisions that are made for the state of Florida.

The September dance will be at Strawberry Square on Sunday, September 18th. It will be REE for everyone as per our membership campaign that ends December 31, 2022. There is also another Membership Dance scheduled in Arcadia on Sunday, December 4th; this dance is also FREE for everyone.

If no one volunteers for the president position by the September Dance, there will be a Zoom meeting of the Association sometime after the dance, to hold the final vote on disbanding the Association and what to do with the remaining funds.

The 46th Annual Fall Fun Fest is still a go. Ted Kennedy and Bill Chesnut will be calling and Earle Collins will be cueing. Due to the above-mentioned situation, the Fall Fun Fest will now be a completely FREE event for everyone. You are still responsible for your lodging. If you have paid for registration, the money will be refunded. If you have ribbons(s) from the 2020 FFF that was canceled due to COVID, they will be accepted this year. Will this be our last FFF? If the Association is disbanded, yes. If the Association remains active, a chairman is needed for the 2023 FFF. The callers and cuer are already scheduled. If no one volunteers to chair this Festival, 2022 will be the last one.

Square and round dancing has been my whole life for about 40 years. I was a member of Buttons & Bows of Lakeland for 31 years and served as president or co-president several times, and was chairman of several committees. Jenny and I co-chaired the 2014 state convention and I have been on the convention committee every year since in some capacity. I was WC president one other time and have been president for the past three years. I am a past president of the Federation when it was a five-year commitment. Jenny and I have co-chaired the FFF for three years. In 2009, I started a small club newsletter that exploded into the DANCERgram. I just can't do all this anymore.

I have two projects to complete for the Federation. They are a new dancer handbook and updating the Hall of Fame. I haven't made a decision yet regarding the DANCERgram.

WHEREAS John Scott, a Lakeland South Rotary Club member, helped organize the 5K Run and has served as the Run Committee's Chairperson since its inception.


